
You will learn more about tissue management and how to augment autogenous bone starting from simple cases to advanced 3D augmentations with the help of 'Khoury techniques'.



Dr. Uğur Meriç - Oral, Dental and Maxillofacial Surgery Specialist

After graduating from Istanbul University Faculty of Dentistry in 1998, Dr. Meriç completed his doctorate program in Oral, Dental and Maxillofacial Surgery Department in 2006 and received the title of specialization. He worked as a lecturer at the same university until 2012. In 2009, he continued his studies on Autogenous Bone Collection and Applications in Implant Applications in the Department of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery of the Faculty of Dentistry, Germany Münster University and in the private clinic of Prof Dr Fouad Khoury. While continuing his work in his private clinic, he is the head of the oral surgery and implantology master program in Muenster Germany International Medical College (IMC) Turkey and organizes international seminars and courses on the subject.

Dr. Tolga Şitilci - Anesthesiology and Reanimation Specialist

Dr Şitilci graduated from Istanbul University Cerrahpaşa Faculty of Medicine in 1999. After working in the private sector for a while, he became an Anesthesiologist and Intensive Care Specialist at the Istanbul Research and Trainig Hospital. He completed his compulsory service in Malatya. He has been working as a lecturer and anesthesiologist at Istanbul University Faculty of Dentistry since 2010.

Dr Şitilci is a specialist in medical emergencies and how to effectively manage stressful situations, giving training on how to correctly diagnose and set treatments, the tricks of the resuscitation process, the management of a stressed patient, the use of emergency kits and specific medicine, as well as conscious sedation application, the relation between dentistry and systemic diseases, emergency medical conditions and treatments in dentistry, dental general anesthesia, methods of applying dental treatments in common systemic diseases and the consultation process.

Gediz Murat Serin - MD, Professor

During his ear-nose-throat (ENT) doctorate, Prof. MD Serin conducted several scientific research ventures and was a speaker, participant and organizer in domestic and international meetings. He has written many international articles and book chapters. He still continues scientific studies and trains students and otolaryngologists.





The skulls are not embalmed, but frozen before use. All cadavers are washed and prepared before the course. The skulls are handled with aesthetics in mind to ensure that the dignity of the donor is respected. No donors have a history of diseases or conditions. You will be instructed to handle the cadavers with care. No information will be given to you about the donor's history.

Staff

The support staff for the course consists of a team of highly skilled and experienced professionals who have lectured in these types of seminar for many years. They also support the participants during the hands-on course.

The Certificate

Upon completion of the Hands-on course, you will receive a certificate with proof of participation in the course.

Taking photos

In order to treat the donors with respect, taking photos or videos is not allowed in the dissecting room.

No Written Test

There will be no written test administered during or after the course to obtain the certificate.
